U.S. News – Law Schools

- 193 law schools fully accredited by the American Bar Association were ranked for 2021 based on a weighted average of 20 measures of quality, up from 12 previously
- Ranking categories
 - Day Program – Carey consistently ranks in the top quartile, remaining in the top 50 of all law schools, and ranks 26th among public institutions for 2021
 - Evening Program – Ranking introduced in 2009 and applied to 69 schools, Carey has been highly ranked, especially among public institutions, but is now 8th overall
 - Specialties – Four additional specialties were added for 2020 and Carey is ranked in all 13, with 4 in the top 20

- 123 medical and osteopathic schools were ranked out of 191 accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education or the American Osteopathic Association
- 68% participation rate for most recent rankings (March 2021)
- Ranking categories
 - Research – Change in methodology to include non-NIH federal research helps UM SOM break into top 30 among all schools and top 10 among publics
 - Primary Care – Despite change in methodology UM SOM continues to rank in top 20 among all schools
 - Diversity and Practice Areas – Four new rankings introduced for 2021 based on demographic and placement data
 - Specialties – Based completely on reputation, UM SOM is not ranked in any medical specialties

U.S. News – Nursing Schools

- Ranked nursing schools are fully accredited by either the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education or the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing
- 43% participation rate (258 out of 597) for most recent rankings (March 2021)
- Ranking categories
 - Master's Program – UM School of Nursing ranks 37th, and is 23rd among public institutions
 - Doctor of Nursing Program – Ranking introduced in 2016, UM SON is ranked 33rd, and is 22nd among public institutions
 - Nursing Anesthesia – Reported as a separate health discipline and ranked by reputation, UM SON was ranked 10th in 2016 for schools with a master's or doctoral program
 - Specialties – All were revised in 2020 and UM SON is ranked in 2 of the 13 specialties, both of which are in the top 10
